WEARY OF FEAR

What are you afraid of?

Fear, at its core, is a *perceived loss of control*.

- So don't be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows. (Matt. 10:31)
- "Don't be afraid; just believe." (Luke 8:50)
- "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid." (Matt. 14:27)
- "Don't be troubled or afraid" (John 14:27)

The Fears we Face Today:

1. Fear of the Unknown

Matthew 1:18 (NIV) This is how the birth of Jesus the Messiah came about: His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be pregnant through the Holy Spirit. ¹⁹ Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the law, and yet did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly.

Why is the VB so important?

Salvation can never come from human effort.

God sent forth his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. (Galatians 4:4-5)

- Unites together the full deity and full humanity in one person.
- It means God can be born in the flesh without sin.

The Holy Spirit will come upon you... therefore the child to be born will be called holy." (Luke 1:35)

2 Fear of Image

²⁰ But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. ²¹ She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins."

How can we overcome our Fear?

1. I am not alone.

²² All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: ²³ "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel" (which means "God with us").

2. Faith for the next step.

²⁴ When Joseph woke up, he did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took Mary home as his wife. ²⁵ But he did not consummate their marriage until she gave birth to a son. And he gave him the name Jesus.
