

What to hold on to when facing change?

Three things Timothy Knew

1. Timothy knew Paul was **BEHIND** him
 - (Philippians 2:22, NIV), “But you know that Timothy has proved himself, **because as a son with his father** he has served with me in the work of the gospel.”
 - (1 Corinthians 4:17a, NIV), “For this reason I have sent to you Timothy, **my son whom I love**, who is faithful in the Lord.”
 - (2 Timothy 1:2, NIV), “To Timothy, **my dear son**: Grace, mercy and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.”
2. Timothy knew Paul was **WITH** him
 - (2 Timothy 1:3-4, NIV), “I thank God, whom I serve, as my ancestors did, with a clear conscience, **as night and day I constantly remember you in my prayers**. Recalling your tears, I long to see you, so that I may be filled with joy.”
3. Timothy knew Paul was **FOR** him
 - (2 Timothy 1:8, NLT) So **never be ashamed** to tell others about our Lord. And don't be ashamed of me, either, even though I'm in prison for him. With **the strength God gives you**, be ready to **suffer** with me for the sake of the Good News.
 - (2 Timothy 1:9, NIV), “He has saved us and called us to a **holy** life...”
