## The Wisdom from Above

## How can I better demonstrate God's wisdom?

"13 Who is wise and understanding among you? Let them show it by their good life, by deeds done in the humility that comes from wisdom. 14 But if you harbor bitter envy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast about it or deny the truth. 15 Such wisdom" does not come down from heaven but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic. 16 For where you have envy and selfish ambition, there you find disorder and every evil practice. 17 But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure; then peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere. 18 Peacemakers who sow in peace reap a harvest of righteousness." - James 3:13-18

"The proverbs of Solomon son of David, king of Israel: for gaining wisdom and instruction; for understanding words of insight; for receiving instruction in prudent behavior, doing what is right and fair; for giving prudence to those who are simple, knowledge and discretion to the young." - Proverbs 1:1-4

Earthly, demonic "wisdom" and wisdom from above.

Wisdom is something we demonstrate in three ways: a good life, deeds done in humility, and humility that comes from wisdom.

"Pride goes before destruction and a haughty spirit before a fall." Proverbs 16:18

- " ... peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere."
- "… (harboring) bitter envy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast about it or deny the truth. <sup>15</sup> Such wisdom" does not come down from heaven but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic. <sup>16</sup> For where you have envy and selfish ambition, there you find disorder and every evil practice." James 3:14-16

## People outside the church are watching us.
