### James 5:13-20

<sup>13</sup>Is anyone among you suffering? Let him **pray**. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing **praise**. <sup>14</sup>Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them **pray** over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. <sup>15</sup>And the **prayer** of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. <sup>16</sup>Therefore, confess your sins to one another and **pray** for one another, that you may be healed. The **prayer** of a righteous person has great power as it is working.

# 4 Specific Times to Pray

- 1. When we are suffering (James 5:13a)
- 2. When we are cheerful (James 5:13b)
- 3. When we are sick (James 5:14-15)
  - a. Call for the elders or church leaders
  - b. Elders pray and anoint with oil, in the name of the Lord
  - c. The Lord raise up the sick
- 4. When we have sinned (James 5:15b-16)
