James 5:13-20

¹³Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing praise. ¹⁴Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. ¹⁵And the prayer of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. ¹⁶Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.

The Power of Prayer

3 Types of Prayers Mentioned

1. Individual Prayers (verse 13)
2. Inviting elders or church leaders to pray (verses 14-15)
3. Prayers for one another (verse 16)

4 Specific Times to Pray

1. When we are suffering (James 5:13a)
2. When we are cheerful (James 5:13b)
3. When we are sick (James 5:14-15)
 - a. Call for the elders or church leaders
 - b. Elders pray and anoint with oil, in the name of the Lord
 - c. The Lord raise up the sick
4. When we have sinned (James 5:15b-16)
