3 Rays of Light

1). God has a PLAN, even if we don't see it.

Genesis 3:15 (NIV) I will put enmity (hostility) between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel.

Genesis 3:21 (NIV) The Lord God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife and clothed them.

2). God has a PURPOSE, even if we don't know it.

I have come...representing my Father (John 5:43)

- I have come to call sinners (Matt 9:13)
- I have come...to do the will of God (John 6:38)
- I have come from Him and He sent me to you (John 7:29)
- I have come as a light to shine in this dark world (John 12:46)
- I have come to save the world (John 12:47)

Isaiah 7:14 (NIV) The Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel.

Matthew 1:21 (NIV) She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins.

3). God has a PROMISE, even if it's not fulfilled yet.

John 1:14 (NIV) The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.
