GOING HOME

HOW DO YOU KNOW FOR SURE YOU'RE GOING TO MAKE IT TO HEAVEN?

1 John 5:13 (NIV) I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life

Realization #1: God Really Loves Me

John 3:16 (NIV) For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

1 John 3:1 (NIV) See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!

Realization #2: I am falling short.

Revelation 21:27 (NIV) Nothing impure will ever enter it, nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.

Acts 4:12 (NIV) Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved."

Titus 3:5 (NIV) He saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the <u>washing</u> of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit

Response #1: I confess my sin.

1 John 1:9 (NIV) If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

Rev. 22:17b (NIV) Let the one who is thirsty come; and let the one who wishes take the free gift of the water of life

Psalm 103:10-12 (NIV) He does not treat us as our sins deserve or repay us according to our iniquities. ¹¹ For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his love for those who fear him; ¹² as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us.

Response #2: I believe in Jesus

Romans 10:9 (RSV) If you confess with your lips that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For man believes with his heart and so is justified, and he confesses with his lips and so is saved.

Matthew 28:19 (NIV) Therefore go and <u>make disciples</u> of all nations, <u>baptizing</u> them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and <u>teaching</u> them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.
