A HOLY GOD

John 17:3 (NIV) "Now this is eternal life: that they <u>know</u> You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent."

<u>Holy</u> literally means He is perfect, pure, set apart, separate, bright.

Hosea 11:9 (NIV) For I am God, and not a man—the Holy One among you.

Psalm 29:2 (NIV) "...worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness." (Ps 96:9) Leviticus 19:2 (NIV) ... Be holy because I, the Lord your God, am holy. Psalm 22:3 (NIV) Yet you are enthroned as the Holy One

1). Isaiah

Isaiah 6:1 (NIV) In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe filled the temple. ² Above him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. ³ And they were calling to one another: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory." ⁴ At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke. ⁵ "Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the Lord Almighty." ⁶ Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar. ⁷ With it he touched my mouth and said, "See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for."

⁸ Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!"

God's holiness affects us in 4 ways

1). We are humbled.

3). Our worship is more genuine.

Psalm 99:5 (NIV) Exalt the Lord our God and worship at his footstool; he is holy. Psalm 30:4 (NIV) Sing the praises of the Lord, you his faithful people; praise his holy name.

4). We desire to be more holy.

1 Peter 1:16 (NIV) Be holy, because I am holy.
