## **Salvation is Central** (Vs. 3-5, 10-12)

1 Peter 1:3 (NIV) ...He has given us new birth into a living hope through the <u>resurrection</u> of Jesus Christ from the dead,  $^4$  and into an <u>inheritance</u> that can never perish, spoil or fade. This inheritance is kept in heaven for you,  $^5$  who through faith are shielded by God's power until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time.

- Resurrection
- Inheritance

Romans 8:17 (NIV) Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory

1 Peter 1:10 (NIV) Concerning this salvation, the prophets, who spoke of the grace that was to come to you, searched intently and with the greatest care...

#### Love from the Heart

1 Peter 1:22 (NIV) Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for each other, <u>love one another deeply, from the heart</u>. <sup>23</sup> For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God.

## Aliens on Earth (vs. 17-21)

1 Peter 1:17 (NIV) Since you call on a Father who judges each person's work impartially, live out your time as foreigners here in reverent fear.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>18</sup> For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors, <sup>19</sup> but with the precious blood of Christ...

# **New Priorities** (vs. 13-15)

1 Peter 1:13 (NIV) Therefore, with minds that are alert and fully sober, set your hope on the grace to be brought to you when Jesus Christ is revealed at his coming. <sup>14</sup> As obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance. <sup>15</sup> But just as he who called you is holy, so <u>be holy in all you do.</u>
