DOES GOD STILL DO MIRACLES LIKE HE DID IN THE BIBLE?

There are many TYPES of Miracles in the Bible:

- Celestial events
- Instantaneous healings
- God takes control over nature
- Animals acting/speaking

Definition of Miracle= an event that defies common expectations of behavior and subsequently is attributed to a superhuman agent; an occurrence that demonstrates God's involvement in the course of human affairs.

Acts 2:43 (NIV) Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles.

Acts 5:12 (NIV) The apostles performed many signs and wonders among the people. 2 Corinthians 12:12 (NIV) I persevered in demonstrating among you the marks of a true apostle, including signs, wonders and miracles.

What is the Purpose of Miracles?

- 1). The Purpose of Miracles is to Authenticate God's Message.
 - Moses (Exodus 4:1-9)
 - Elijah (1 Kings 18:36-39)
 - Jesus (John 10:37)

Matthew 14:33 (NIV) Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."

Acts 15:12 (NIV) The whole assembly became silent as they listened to Barnabas and Paul telling about the <u>signs and wonders God had done</u> among the Gentiles through them

2). To teach what the Kingdom of God was like.

Matthew 11:5 (NIV) The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is proclaimed to the poor.

"There were fewer miracles in the Bible than you probably think, and more miracles today than you probably know." -John Piper

Psalm 77:11 (NIV) I will remember the deeds of the Lord; yes, I will remember your miracles of long ago.

Followers of Jesus actually SUFFERED.

- They got sick, persecuted
- Thrown in prison, killed.
- Beaten, tortured, beheaded.
- Confused, frustrated, hurt, and disappointed.
- Arguments, theological disputes, conflicts

Luke 16:31 (NIV) He said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead.'

Matthew 27:40 (NIV) You who are going to destroy the temple and build it in three days, save yourself! Come down from the cross, if you are the Son of God!" ⁴¹ In the same way the chief priests, the teachers of the law and the elders mocked him. ⁴² "He saved others," they said, "but he can't save himself! He's the king of Israel! Let him come down now from the cross, and we will believe in him.

Jesus had a BIGGER PURPOSE in mind, than just doing miracles.

We can trust God whether we understand it or not. Whether He does a miracle or not. We can still believe in Jesus. We can trust in His sovereignty.

**A mature faith is NOT one that is conditional. Based on miracles. Based on our conditions or understanding.
