Who are you?

3 ways to Discover more of your True Identity in Christ.

1). Act of Baptism

Matthew 3:13 (NIV) Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to be baptized by John. ¹⁴ But John tried to deter him, saying, "I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?"

Matthew 3:11 (NIV) I baptize you with water for repentance. But after me comes one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.

Matthew 3:15 (NIV) Jesus replied, "Let it be so <u>now</u>; it is proper for us to do this to <u>fulfill all</u> <u>righteousness</u>." Then John consented.

Matthew 3:16a (NIV) As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water.

2). The Presence of the Spirit

Matthew 3:16b (NIV) At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him.

The Holy Spirit...

- helps us in temptations
- convicts us of sin so we confess
- comforts us in our struggles
- gives us spiritual gifts
- guides us to truth
- empowers our worship
- intercedes for us to the Father

3). Affirmation of God

Matthew 3:17 (NIV) And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased."

- Psalm 2:7 (NIV) I will proclaim the Lord's decree: He said to me, "You are my son; today I have become your father.
- Isaiah 42:1 (NIV) Here is my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen one <u>in whom I delight</u>; I will put my Spirit on him, and he will bring justice to the nations.

- 3). I am what PEOPLE SAY about me.
