THE POWER TO OVERCOME TEMPTATION

Matthew 4:1 (NIV) Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.

James 1:13 (NIV) When tempted, no one should say, "God is tempting me." For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone.

Temptation #1: To Be Self-Serving

Matthew 4:2 (NIV) After fasting forty days and forty nights, he was hungry. ³ The tempter came to him and said, "If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread."

Matthew 4:4 (NIV) Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'"

Satan's Seeds of Doubt:

- You deserve to be happy.
- Believe in yourself/You can do anything.
- You deserve it.
- God helps those who help themselves.

Temptation #2: To Be Powerful

Matthew 4:5 (NIV) Then the devil took him to the holy city and had him stand on the highest point of the temple. ⁶ "If you are the Son of God," he said, "throw yourself down. For it is written: "He will command his angels concerning you, and they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone."

What are some common attractive baits

- Money/possessions
- Sex outside of it's proper context
- A new relationship
- Appearance/image

Matthew 4:7 (NIV) Jesus answered him, "It is also written: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.'"

Temptation #3: To Be Spectacular.

Matthew 4:8 (NIV) Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendor. ⁹ "All this I will give you," he said, "<u>if you will</u> bow down and worship me."

Matthew 4:10 (NIV) Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written: 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only." ¹¹ Then the devil left him, and angels came and attended him.
