

WHO'S SITTING AT YOUR TABLE?

Psalm 23:1 (HCSB) *The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I lack. ² He lets me lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside quiet waters. ³ He renews my life; He leads me along the right paths for His name's sake. ⁴ Even when I go through the darkest valley, I fear no danger, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff —they comfort me.*

⁵ You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.

Matthew 26:29 (HCSB) *But I tell you, from this moment I will not drink of this fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it in a new way in My Father's kingdom with you.*

Revelation 19:7,9 (HCSB) *Let us be glad, rejoice, and give Him glory, because the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has prepared herself... ⁹ Then he said to me, "Write: Those invited to the marriage feast of the Lamb are fortunate!" He also said to me, "These words of God are true."*

Revelation 3:20 (HCSB) *Listen! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and have dinner with him, and he with Me.*

Psalm 23:5b (HCSB) *You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.*

Anointing=to rub, to bathe, to massage

David was anointed:

- 1). In front of his brothers (1 Samuel 16:13)
- 2). Men of Judah anointed David (2 Samuel 2:4)
- 3). In front of all the tribes of Israel (2 Samuel 5:3)

2 Corinthians 1:21 (HCSB) *Now it is God who strengthens us, with you, in Christ and has anointed us.*

Psalms 23:5 (HCSB) *You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.*
